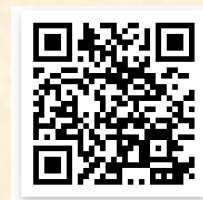
**Target participants:** Social service administrators, frontline practitioners, social policy analysts, students, and people who are interested in these topics and our postgraduate programmes.
