

Practicum Course on Narrative Drawing Intervention

OBJECTIVE

To develop participants' practical competence in using this psychological tool in the following aspects:

- Analytical ability in the projection of children's and adult's drawings
- Understanding the symbolic meaning of one's drawing
- Application of Projective Drawing in the conduct of counseling

FORMAT

- Experiential learning + live demonstration + participant case presentations and analysis

CONTENT

- Adopting opened, macro and professional attitude toward case presentations and analysis (each participant is required to take part in two case reports, for practicum purpose)
- Live demonstration and elaborations of Narrative Drawing Intervention by trainer, allowing participants to gain clear understanding of the essence of Narrative Drawing Intervention and its applications
- Focusing on clients of different age groups, applying verbal and nonverbal skills in a flexible manner, in order to fulfil therapeutic outcomes
- Analyzing the importance of narratives and how it can be applied to making sense of the underlying issues of the clients, hence to explicitly address them
- Understanding the application of different drawing themes in depth
- Consolidating techniques and guidelines in analyzing drawings

TRAINER

Dr. Monica Wong, PsyD.(黃曉紅) is an author, clinical psychologist, registered art therapist, regional representative of Asia for the Australian Creative Arts Therapies Association, the first trauma specialist and trainer in Asia certified by the National Institute for Trauma and Loss in Children (USA), founder of the Psycho-Art Therapy Association, advisor of the Eugene Group, academic director of the Hong Kong Institute for Counselling Professionals and the Psycho-adventure Training Center, and founder of the Society for Junior Writers of Hong Kong. Dr. Wong has been a professional trainer delivering courses on NDI (formerly known as Projective Drawing), Enneagram, and Storytelling for the CUHK regularly since 2006. Besides, she is often invited to conduct seminars and workshops for universities and colleges, secondary and primary schools, hospitals, governmental departments, enterprises and non-profit organizations.

Graduated from Philosophy in CUHK, Dr. Wong has performed attentive research in psychology and psychotherapies in recent years and obtained her master's degree in counselling from Monash University in Australia and her doctoral degree in clinical psychology from California School of Professional Psychology, AIU (USA). She has been to Australia to follow the world-class psychotherapy master, Mr. Michael White for studying Narrative Therapy. She has been supervised by internationally renowned art therapy masters Dr. Cathy Malchiodi and Ms. Cornelia Elbrecht in Art Therapy. She is one of the authors and hosts of *Stories from Afar* (尋找他鄉的故事) and *Success Stories Series* (傑出華人系列), both large-scale televised documentaries. She is also the co-author of best-seller books, *Open the Locks of the Hearts – Enneagram* (打開心鎖的密碼—九型人格心理學), *Draw the Feelings out from Your Heart - Projective Drawing* (畫出心中情), and the author of *Walking Through the Ruin of the Hearts - Case study of Projective Drawing and Narrative Therapy* (走出心靈的廢墟—投射繪畫與敘事治療實錄) and *Happiness Is Around the Corner of Life* (快樂在生命轉彎處). She has newly developed her own clinical model: Narrative Drawing Intervention (NDI) and presented it in a number of international conferences, universities and hospitals in the United States of America, Australia, Mexico, Singapore, the mainland China, Hong Kong and Macau. More than ten thousand of helping professionals have been trained over the decade. Dr. Wong has led 14 volunteer teams to earthquake-hit areas in Sichuan since 2008, and has been leading another helping professional team to provide psychotherapies to school teachers and students who are under great pressure in Hong Kong since 2015. She has also hosted an international conference on art therapy in China in 2013 and another one in Hong Kong in 2016.
