# Introduction

How the archetype of the Clown can be used as a vehicle for healing? Each of us is born into this world with an essential innocence, openness and sense of wonder. As we "mature" and become adults, we lose much of this



openness as we try to fit in and succeed. In the process of maturing we shut away our spontaneity and our willingness to take risks and look foolish. And yet, deep within us, that small child is still there, waiting to be set free.

The Clown Therapy work is an invitation to unlock the child within and to come out and play. With the freedom provided by the mask of the Red Nose, we are invited to access our full range of emotions and expressions that we have long suppressed. We are encouraged to take our selves to the extreme and to the absurd, breaking down our sense of what is right and proper, and express our REAL feelings.

# What is clown therapy?



Clown Therapy is a form of Drama Therapy that uses the exploration of the personal Clown Character within each of us as a vehicle for self-discovery, and self-growth through use of Drama Therapy exercises, improvisation and play techniques.

The Clown has existed throughout the ages in all cultures. As the Fool, the Trickster and the Buffoon, it has traditionally been a character where our hidden tendencies and desires could find a voice and a place to express themselves.

In this Clown Therapy workshop, we will begin to discover our own Clown Character that lives inside us. We will explore the world of our Clown, and in so doing have an opportunity to shed light on parts of our own hidden psyches in a safe and playful way.

## Target participants

Social workers, therapists, teachers, parents, theatre artists, and anybody who is interested using play as a vehicle for personal exploration, healing and release.

### Style of learning

Drama therapy theory, experiential learning, interactive and hands on practice.

## Trainer

Christina Lewis, BA in Comparative Religion, MA in Drama Therapy and Psychology and Master Clown, is the Founder and the Director of the Clown School of San Francisco where she teaches and directs students in the art of Clown. She also works for California Institute of Integral Studies as a Director of Self Revelatory performance pieces for the Master's Program in Drama Therapy.

She is also a Special Education teacher for students with multiple and severe disabilities, and she uses the Clown modality to reach and support her students. Christina performs and teaches workshops as her alter ego "Dotty Moppet" throughout the year for children all over the San Francisco Bay Area.
