Gestalt therapy with children: The dance between caregivers and child By Dr. Margherita Spagnuolo Lobb (March 6-7, 2019)

Introduction

This workshop tries to outline how to face the actual clinical work with children. It will present new tools to help children and their families to feel part of the human community, in a way that is not desensitized.

This workshop will propose a new, more relational, description of caregivers/child interactions and contact making. The idea of dance will be used, which includes the feelings and the movements of both caregivers and child. The "dance steps", an observational tool for dyads, will be presented and experimented. It is in line with contemporary studies of neurosciences and intersubjectivity, and with a phenomenological, aesthetic and field oriented language.

Participants will learn to observe the child's suffering in a relational way.

Learning objectives

- 1) To look at the caregivers/child relation from an aesthetic and phenomenological view
- 2) To switch the attention from what caregivers or child do to the reciprocity of their ineraction
- 3) To observe the "dance" between caregivers and child with specific aesthetic and phenomenological cathegories
- 4) To measure the observed dance between caregivers and child with a validated observational tool
- 5) To use the observational tool to orient the therapeutic intervention basing on aesthetic and Gestalt criteria
