Professor Ma Lai-chong, Joyce (Ph.D., R.S.W., Clinical Fellow and Approved Supervisor, AAMFT)

Emeritus Professor Department of Social Work The Chinese University of Hong Kong

Professor Ma is an Emeritus Professor of the Department of Social Work, The Chinese University of Hong Kong. Her specialties and research interests cover the areas of family therapy, multiple family therapy, and mental health with focuses on eating disorders, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and Intellectual Disabilities (ID). Professor Ma is a Clinical Fellow and an Approved Supervisor of the American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy (AAMFT). Professor Ma is the founder of the Family and Group Practice Research Center, the Department of Social Work of The Chinese University of Hong Kong. She was the president of the International Family Therapy Association (IFTA) in 2019–2021. Professor Ma has published 7 books and 118 refereed journal articles at international, regional and local venues of significant impact and visibility.
