Clown Therapy is a form of Drama Therapy that uses the exploration of the personal Clown Character within each of us as a vehicle for self-discovery, and self-growth through use of Drama Therapy exercises, improvisation and play techniques.

In this Clown therapy online workshop, we will begin to discover our own Clown Character that lives inside us. We will learn how to use the Clown Therapy method to explore and illuminate intra psychic issues that are relevant in the here and now. We will learn how to construct Self Revelatory performance material out of our current conflicts to create understanding and healing.

Target Participants

Social workers, therapists, teachers, parents, theatre artists and anyone interested in using play as a vehicle for personal exploration, healing and release.
