Clinical Supervision Group (Oct 2019) by Professor Joyce L. C. MA

Target Group

This Clinical Supervision Group is designed for helping professionals who have Master of Social Work, Master of Arts in Family Counselling and Family Education or its equivalence, preferably with theoretical base and clinical practice experience in family therapy.

Objectives

The aim of this course is to enable participants to apply knowledge and skills of family therapy and to assist participants critically appraise related ethical issues and resolve ethical dilemmas in clinical practice. The presenters will be required to bring their own cases of families with difficulties for video tape review and discussion with the trainer, while the observers will observe the case presentation and discussion process. The participants are expected to be grouped based on the nature of problem of their presented families in order to facilitate a more in-depth and academic discussion.

Trainer

Prof. Joyce L. C. Ma is Professor of the Department of Social Work. Her specialties and research interests cover the areas of family therapy and multiple family therapy, mental health with recent focuses on eating disorders and

attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD). Teaching at the Department of Social Work, The Chinese University of Hong Kong since 1988, Prof. Ma is a Clinical Fellow and an Approved Supervisor of the American Association of Marriage and Family Therapy (AAMFT), founder of the Shengang Family Treatment Center, Nanshan Hospital in Shenzhen and the Director of the Family and Group Practice Research Centre of the Department. She was appointed the Co-Clinical Director, Academy of Family Therapy, Hong Kong in January 2013, and Fellow of the Asian Academy of Family Therapy (AAFT). She is the President of the International Family Therapy Association (IFTA) from July 2019 to June 2021.

Prof. Ma is the Programme Director of the UBS/Operational Santa Claus Leadership Programme for Senior Executives of Non-government Organizations, featuring a tripartite collaboration the NGOs, businesses and academia from 2015 to the present.

She has published seven books (five Chinese books and two English books) and 100 refereed journal articles at international, regional and local venues of significant impact and visibility. Given her ongoing efforts and remarkable performance in teaching and research, she has received Faculty Exemplary Teaching Award and Vice-Chancellor's Exemplary Teaching Award in 2009, HKU 60th Anniversary Distinguished Alumni Award in 2010, Justice of the Peace from 2011 onwards, best paper award in the journal Youth Exploration in 2012 and Long Service Award in 2014.
